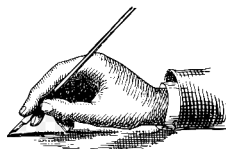

TESTIMONY OF THOSE WHO DO NOT LOVE THEIR LIVES

Artist Sunil has a child sitting in front of him on a chair to sketch a portrait. Hours have passed. The child is restless. The artist says that he is drawing his own figure. What is this? A few lines here, a few there and a few colors in between. Where is his picture? "This is just a waste... This is not my picture," the child shouted. Be calm, my son! I am still working on you. Sunil said that when we unexpectedly draw a line that God sees as ugly in us - it could be a disease... or the loss of loved ones or an act of violence, we become restless. Is this all working together for good? What good is to come out of this? What good is left after everything has collapsed?

We often do not understand the meaning of the tragedies that come into our lives. But God has something beautiful in store for us in His plan... He who began a good work in us (remember that what was started there is a good work) will complete it.... It may take time for its completion "until

the day of Christ". Hence wait. The delay always makes the picture more beautiful.

Paul writes this letter to the Philippians from a prison in Rome. Isn't the imprisonment of the faithful missionary Paul a setback for evangelism, humanly speaking, yes! But it was a plan that God had worked out in His foreknowledge. Paul says,

"But I want you to know, brethren, that the things which happened to me have



actually turned out for the furtherance of the gospel, so that it has become evident to the whole palace guard, and to all the rest, that my chains are in Christ; and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more



bold to speak the word without fear.”
(Philippians 1:12-14)

There is a reality that we often do not understand – the reality is that the work is God's! The thought that we recognize is that God is working through us. But we need to recognize the great reality that we are God's work. We are doing God's work. We are always busy working with the thought that we are running around and often God does not get to build us. How sad!

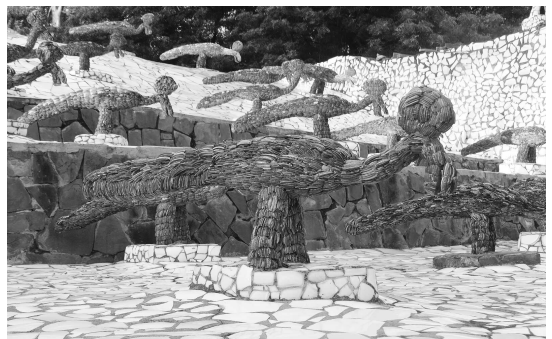

We too may be just waste materials (Scrap) to the world. But if this scrap reaches the hands of the sculptor of the universe, it will not be difficult to make a beautiful sculpture there!

Something beautiful, something good. "He understands all our confusions. "All you have to offer Him is your brokenness and brokenness and He will do something beautiful in you.

I have been able to see many of my dear tribal brothers living well and being very clean and tidy. Only a few have been seen as drunkards and dirty. I have written these topics openly only to help and pray for each tribal group and their ways of life as much as we can. Therefore, I request your help and prayers by recognizing this issue in that capacity.

May they live well by breathing good clean air, eating wild tubers and eating unadulterated vegetables. Yet they will not seek treatment if they get sick. Will not use the hospital facilities for the poor sisters to give birth. Instead, they will perform witchcraft and pujas. They should be educated and saved.

No matter how pleasant the language they speak is, it is an unwritten language,

instead of that, they should learn a written language and send their children to schools for education, gain knowledge and get good jobs. Only if they want to come into the mainstream of society will they be saved. This is where the work of the Tribal Mission comes in.

The Mission helps them through such activities as medical camps, schools and de-addiction centers. The Word of God is also shared with them. Therefore, the work of the Tribal Mission is the greatest help that we can extend to them these days.

No one should be allowed to perish because they do not know the truth or do not get an opportunity.





..... FROM BETHANY ATTAPPADI, WITH LOVE... ..

"Beloved in the Lord, greetings from Bethany Attappadi."

It has been about a month since the new academic year 2026- 27 began, and 14 senior students have written the 10th class exams and received good grades and have gone on to further studies. We pray for them and remember those who have sponsored them over the years. Praising and thanking God for them.

This past summer vacation had been a very busy time for Bethany Campus. We had to find time, people and money for the whitewashing, painting and repair work during the vacation and for the various camps that had started. God heard our prayers and prepared everything in due time. After the children went home for the vacation, at the end of March, 5 people from Kumbanad (IBCS) Bible School came and stayed here for a month's field visit as part of their training program. They did a good job with home visits and village visits. Earlier, youths from many institutions used to come to Attappady. This is the first time after Covid. If anyone is interested, definitely come..... We will arrange the necessary facilities.... Let us know..... Come..... A roller skating coaching camp was held for about 40 children every day for a month at Bethany School Ground from April 6th. Roller skating training has started in the school from this academic year. Children are participating in this new program with great enthusiasm. May national stars emerge from here.

A team of college students from Thrissur (EGF/EU) came as a team under the leadership of Brother Lino Kuriyala. They stayed here for 2 days (May 2,3) and visited many mission centers. I pray that the thoughts of missionary work will continue to rule the hearts of these youths. I express my gratitude and love to these loved ones.

The annual retreat of the Tribal Mission was to be held in the first week of April. Many preparations were made but it was postponed. By the grace of God, it was held from May 4th to 7th. Special meetings were arranged for children and teenagers. Brother Deepak Ranganath, Wayanad led the team and Ms. Jita V. from Kottayam prepared the Pampady team. Glory to God, this meeting helped many children of the missionaries to get saved and to take decision to be baptized.

The heavy rain that fell the day before the retreat cooled the Vattalaki campus, which was scorching under the sun, and in the following days it rained all around. The cool wind blew and we sat under the hot and ripe asbestos sheets without worrying as God gave us good weather. After the retreat, it rained continuously for two days. God, who controls everything, revealed His hand. Praise be to God. From May 21 to 24, All Kerala Gloria Football matches were held at Bethany Stadium under the auspices of Sports Coalition Ministry in



Thrissur. About 200 people stayed in the camp and enthusiastically participated in the league matches. In the meetings held at night, the life experiences of prominent sportsmen were shared. About 50 sportsmen accepted Jesus as their Lord. Glory to God. We do remember with appreciation and thank Brother Lernal Thomas, Brother Prince, Brother Thomas, School PT Sir Ezra G. etc.

LETTER FROM THE ADMIN SECRETARY

May 2026 was a busy month. The Almighty God helped us to organize the annual gathering (Retreat) of the missionaries on 5th, 6th and 7th May at Bethany English Medium School, Attappady. The gathering was blessed by the presence of tribal missionaries, family members and committee members. General Secretary Dr. K. Muralidhar gave the main leadership to the gathering. On 9th May, the general body meeting of the mission was held at the administrative office in Perumbavoor and the work report and income and expenditure accounts for 2025-26 were presented. Then the office bearers for 2026-27 were elected. The special seminar organized by Thiruvalla Believers Medical College on May 10 for doctors and medical students was a great blessing. Dr. K. Muralidhar and Dr. Hudson led the seminar. On May 16, the prayer partners of the mission at Nagarkovil, under the leadership of Dr. Sam Sahayadas, organized a medical camp at Mankulam in Idukki and

examined many indigenous tribals and distributed free medicines. Moreover, free spectacles were distributed to those who underwent eye examination.

On Monday morning, May 18, I went to Manchester, England, to stay with my son and family for a few days. On the advice of the General Secretary, I got to know Pastor Tommy Kurian, an early worker at Bethany Hospital and a great helper of the mission. On Sunday, the 31st, at his invitation, I was able to attend their Agape Christian Fellowship and talk about the work of the mission. A brief video presentation of the work of the mission was also shown in the church. They greatly appreciated the work of the mission and offered financial assistance and also promised to support more in future.

On Sunday, June 7th, God helped me to accept the invitation of the IPC Bethel Church in Belfast to go there and talk about the mission and show a video. I gratefully remember that the church members, led



by Pastor Jacob John, gave financial assistance to the mission and said that they would pray and cooperate with the work of the mission.

On Sunday, June 14th, as invited by the Liverpool Prayer Fellowship, I had the opportunity to go there and worship God with the minister, Pastor George Kutty. The Lord helped me to talk about the mission and showed videos in that church too. They also helped our mission financially and will continue to help.

The Lord helped me to be in prayer most of the days as there was a fasting prayer



lasting twenty-one days from the first of June in the great church of Manchester where my son worships God. As the Spirit

of God illuminated my mind, from the first of July to the 31st of December, the Lord helped me to arrange fasting prayers in the churches of the Tribal Mission for the blessing of the mission, for the health and ministry of the General Secretary Dr. K. Muralidhar and for the emergence of new workplaces in the tribal area.
